Home Injury Control

Home Injury Control is a program to prevent injuries in the homes of disabled and frail senior citizens who could not otherwise afford safety devices.

Types of devices

Home Injury Control can install any of the following safety devices:

- Grab bars
- Transfer benches
- Handheld shower heads
- Toilet assist rails
- Raised toilet seat
- Bath chairs
- Smoke alarms
- Exterior & interior hand rails

Eligibility

- A Macomb County resident.
- A one time service can be provided to anyone 60 years of age or older who does not qualify for devices under any other program.

Cost

 It is suggested that the senior make an appropriate contribution to share in the cost of providing the service. The suggested donation amount is \$10 per device.



Temporary Modular Ramps

Macomb Community Action also installs temporary modular ramps on a short-term basis for wheelchair-bound senior citizens and temporary wheelchair users. There is a nominal monthly lease fee. When the ramps are no longer needed, they are removed and used for new clients. For questions or for more information about these programs contact 586-469-5228.
